

Seaver Close fix for compatibility issues with unsupported browsers

The following steps will create a shortcut on the desktop to get to Seaver Close. This will force Seaver Close to open with Windows Explorer, not your internet browser. This has been tested on Windows XP.

1. Right click on an open area of the desktop.
2. Click New – Shortcut.
3. Where it says Type the location of the item: put in [%windir%\explorer.exe ftp://ftp.seavertitle.com](#)
The only space is between **explorer.exe** and **ftp**
4. Where it says Type a name for this shortcut: put in **Seaver Close**
5. Hit [Finish]

Double click on the shortcut to access Seaver Close
